AAC ID Cards

All dogs must have an AAC ID Card to compete in AAC events. Register at www.aac.ca.

Dog AAC ID cards must be shown on check-in if your dog has not trialed at a CODAC event before, or since 2018 with the new jump heights.

Dog Measurement

To limit unnecessary contact and to eliminate the need for measuring at every trial, judges will provide a one-time measure for dogs under 2 years. A temporary measurement card will be e-mailed to the handler by AAC to be used during this time. Dogs under 2 years of age may compete with their temporary card until they reach 2 years of age, at which point they will require an official measurement. Judges will sign Dog ID cards for dogs 2 years and older. Dogs over 2 years of age must be measured until they have their final height circled on their ID card.

You must notify the Trial Secretary in advance if your dog requires measuring.

Food

Class Changes

A dog that has entered a trial and subsequently earns a title shall be permitted to move up. Please notify the Trial Secretary as soon as possible. Class Move-up Forms will be available at the trial for same-day move ups.

Ribbons and Prizes

There is self-service for Q and placement ribbons. If you have earned a Title please notify the Trial Chair who will arrange for your ribbon(s).

*** Our trial site is located in the center of a turf farm. Dogs may be walked only in designated areas, not on the turf or the road.**

Junior Handlers

Junior handlers must obtain a Junior Handler Identification Number prior to entering the trial as a Junior Handler. Go to www.aac.ca for more information.

Senior/Disabled Handlers

Senior handlers (65 years and over) and handlers with disability may request a modified course time and a modified points requirement (see below for details). Proof of disability or age will not be requested by the host club. A handler must indicate on the entry form if entering as senior/disabled handler (check SD box) to receive modified times/reduced number of points.

Crating

Crating will be from your vehicle and a few spots in the paddock area. There will be no crating inside the barn. Crating in the paddocks must maintain a minimum of 2 meters distance between handlers. Club crates will not be available for use.

Accommodation

Please note that due to site and space restrictions there will be NO on site camping. There are several campsites and hotels within five minutes of the site. For additional information, contact the trial secretary.

Notice to Exhibitors

Full refunds will be provided to handlers having to withdraw from the trial due to COVID-19 related illness or in the case of an injury to a dog or handler or bitches in season. Please notify the trial secretary as soon as possible.

Please note that this trial may be cancelled or altered on short notice based on the most current provincial & regional health orders relating to the COVID-19 pandemic. Full refunds will be given if the trial is cancelled, or entry numbers reduced.

Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of AAC Rules and Regulations, including, but not limited to, the following:

This event is held under AAC Rules and Regulations (as of January 1, 2020) and is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, purebred or mixed breed, except aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs showing signs of aggression.

The organizing committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the rules and regulations of the AAC and shall conform to AAC specifications.

No food shall be permitted on course; this includes obstacle familiarization.

Collars in the ring – dog will be allowed to wear a close-fitting collar, with no attachments, in the ring.

For FEO runs only, toys will be permitted in the ring.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children

create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the trial grounds. In such cases, no refund of fees will be paid.

All dogs must be kept in their ex pen, crate, or on leash when not in the ring. All dogs must be in control when leaving the ring after their run. Any dog engaging in aggressive or out-of-control behavior upon exit of the ring will be disqualified and/or be required to leave the trial grounds. In such cases, no refund of fees will be paid.

AAC BIS Pilot Project

AAC announced a pilot project allowing bitches in season (BIS) attend sanctioned AAC trials. The pilot starts July 1, 2022 and ends July 1, 2023. CODAC is participating in this pilot project. Therefore, BIS will be allowed to attend AAC sanctioned trials at the CODAC facility during the pilot period. BIS will be allowed on site and will be allowed to compete in trials, following the policies outlined below:

- Handlers of BIS are required to notify the trial secretary as soon as it is known
- All competitors will be notified that there is a BIS at the trial
- The handler of the BIS or the handler of any other dog entered may withdraw from the trial with a full refund if they choose not to compete
- The crating and movements, including pottying, of the BIS will be limited to designated areas so that the BIS is kept isolated from other dogs at all times
- Crating will be done in a vehicle
- The BIS will wear well-fitted protective panties, specifically designed for the purpose of containing seasonal discharges. The panties will be removed only for pottying and, when crated. Panties must be replaced immediately following pottying. Panties will be worn when running a course
- BIS will run at the end of the class
- "BIS" will be noted next to the dog's name on the gate list
- BIS will wear a red bandana (to be removed when running a course), provided by CODAC, to identify the dog as a BIS.

Directions to trial site:

From the North: on Highway 97 you will pass the Kelowna International Airport and the turnoff to the University of British Columbia – Okanagan and then go over an overpass. Immediately after the overpass, turn East (left) onto Hereron Road. Turn North (left) almost immediately onto Bulman Road. You will see a sign telling you about golf courses. Turn into the first driveway on the right. It is marked with a turf farm sign and a private property sign. Drive down (note 20 km/h speed limit) to the red barn and park on the North side.

From the South/West: Travel through Kelowna towards Vernon on Highway 97 and as you are leaving the city, you will pass Edwards Rd and be approaching the exit overpass to UBCO. Turn right just before the overpass onto Hereron Road. Turn North (left) almost immediately onto Bulman Road. You will see signs telling you about golf courses. Turn into the first driveway on the right. It is marked with a turf farm sign and a private property sign. Drive down (note 20 km/h speed limit) to the red barn and park on the North side.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry by AAC and the **Central Okanagan Dog Agility Club** (the “Organizing Club”) and the opportunity to have the Dog participate, compete in and/or be judged at this event or trial (the “Event”), I, the undersigned, agree as follows:

1. I certify that I am the actual owner of the Dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner of the Dog and that the Dog is not a hazard to persons, property or other dogs.
2. I agree that AAC or the Organizing Club for the Event may refuse my entry for any reason that it deems to be sufficient.
3. I understand and acknowledge that participation in the Event carries certain risks, including, but not limited to injuries (including serious injuries and death) to myself, the Dog, another dog under my control or persons attending as my guests (my “**Related Parties**”), damage to property and other losses. I waive any and all claims that I have or may have in the future against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue AAC, the Organizing Club or any of the directors, executives, committees, representatives, employees, volunteers or agents of either AAC or the Organizing Club (the “**Personnel**”) for any injury, death, property damage or other loss that I or my Related Parties sustain due to any cause whatsoever, including negligence, breach of contract, breach of duty, statutory or otherwise, or mistakes or errors of judgment of any kind.
4. I assume full responsibility for the conduct of myself and my Related Parties during the entirety of the Event. I agree to indemnify and save harmless AAC, the Organizing Club and the Personnel from and against any and all claims that may be made against them or costs, fees, expenses or liability (including, without limitation, lawyers’ fees on a solicitor and own client basis) incurred by AAC, the Organizing Club or the Personnel that may arise due to:
 - a. any act or omission of myself, my Related Parties or any party for whom I am liable at law; or
 - b. aggressive behaviour by the Dog or any other dog under my control.
